

Camera On/Camera Off



This activity is done best with virtual teams with the ability to see each other on camera.

Instructions for the facilitator (don't share this with your team)

The facilitator will say a statement (suggestions found below). If that statement is true about the employee, they will turn their camera ON. If it's not true about the employee, they will turn their camera OFF. When employees turn their cameras on, take a minute to celebrate and call out anything that seems relevant and keep the flow of the game going. Have everyone turn their cameras off after each sentence. There are suggested statements below, but feel free to add your own as well.

Instructions to share with your team:

We're going to play a game called CAMERA ON, CAMERA OFF! I will read you a statement and if that statement is true about you, you turn your camera ON. If it isn't true about you, then you keep your camera off. After every sentence, we will all turn our cameras off to reset. Let's try a practice round... everybody turn your cameras off! (wait for employees to turn cameras off) Okay - turn your camera ON if you drank coffee this morning!!! (wait for employees to turn cameras on) AWESOME! Thumbs up if you understand the game! Any questions? Let's play!

Statements

Camera on if:

- you like to eat bread.
- you are a dog person!
- you have ever been to the Grand Canyon (or want to go)!
- you are born and raised here
- you have ever left the country before!
- you like watching sports!
- you are a morning person
- you need alone time to refuel
- you have a green thumb
